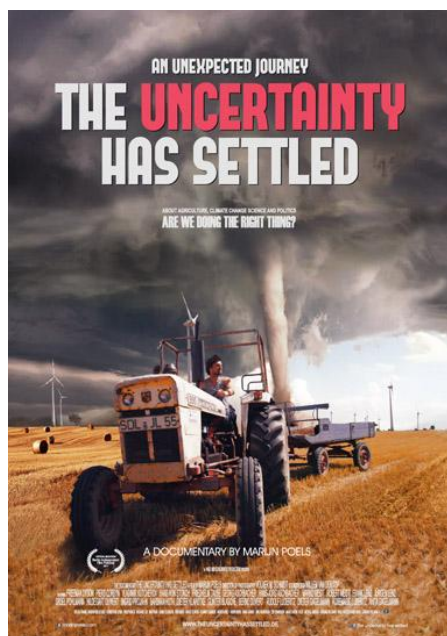


Invitation World premiere The Uncertainty Has Settled February 8 / 12 in Berlin

**The Uncertainty Has Settled, a daring documentary about Agriculture, Climate change and energy, is opening the Berlin Independent Film Festival at Thursday.**

Storyline - During a sabbatical Marijn Poels, a Berlin based journalist, gets confronted with the current situation of European agriculture. Farmers have become energy suppliers. His curiosity has been piqued - are we doing the right thing? - from where his journey starts. The 90 minutes film is opening up a controversial discussion with the audience. Poels, as a true environmental activist, questioning the mainstream climate ideology and therefore he is visiting different critical academic scientists

throughout the world. Balancing between the big controversial scientific dogmas of climate and energy. Without claiming a truth the film clearly sends a message. That politics, NGO's and media are influencing the mainstream believes and leaving no room for a healthy debate.

The makers of this production decided to finance the film by themselves without external funding to avoid politics, propaganda and opinion makers. Filmmaker Marijn Poels will be present after both screenings.

The premiere is part of the ninth Berlin Independent Film Festival. One of the most appreciated Indie Film Festivals in Europe. The festival has selected "The Uncertainty Has Settled" within the program as official selection.
